Eligibility, FEE-FREE TAFE

To be eligible for Fee-Free TAFE funding, participants must be:

- an Australian or New Zealand citizen, Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency
- a Queensland resident
- 15 years or over and no longer at school
- · not currently enrolled in training
- Not already accessed Fee-Free TAFE


